## Kids Sea Camp Palau Package information Nov 20-29 2009

### **Join KSC and Discover the Eighth Wonder of the World!**

Of the thousands of idyllic islands that dot the vast Pacific Ocean, Micronesia's westernmost island chain known as the Palau archipelago, is perhaps a best kept secret. Rich in natural beauty, steeped in ancient culture, Palau is truly Mother Nature's work of art!

Vibrant coral reefs teeming with marine life; hidden lakes full of ancient creatures; white sandy beaches; thriving rainforests and spectacular waterfalls offer a splendid backdrop to Palau's fascinating geological formations, significant archaeological sites and world renowned underwater wonders.

Calm protected waters, soft sand beaches, hidden marine lakes, Micronesia's richest flora and fauna, remarkable birding, superb snorkeling and world class scuba diving make Palau the perfect place for adventure, exploration or just simple peaceful relaxation. We hope you join in the fun as KSC discovers this wonder of the world!

### **GEOLOGY, BIOLOGY AND BIO-DIVERSITY**

#### **Geology**

The Palau Islands are an archipelago composed of about 350 islands and atolls having an area of approximately 160 square miles. Babeldaob is the largest island, having an area of 128.5 square miles. The highest altitude is Mt. Ngerekelehuus in its northwestern part, 794 feet above sea level. Palau can be classified into four types of island: volcanic; reef and atoll; low platform; and high limestone. Several of the islands are a combination of these four basic types. The volcanic islands of Babeldaob, Meyuns, Malakal and Koror make up most of the land area.

All the islands except two small atolls to the north and the islands of Angaur and Peleliu to the southwest are enclosed within the barrier or fringing reef.

Palau's eastern shore drops off steeply to the Palau Trench which reaches a maximum depth of 27,000 feet about 30 miles offshore while the western shore slopes gradually to depths of 18,000 feet about 250 miles to the west.

#### **Marine Bio-Diversity**

Palau is located at a cross roads where the enormous Pacific Ocean meets the Philippine Sea, creating one of the worlds' richest zones of tropical marine bio-diversity, making it a truly world-class scuba diving destination that few places on the globe can rival. Palau's marine eco-systems include barrier reefs, fringing reefs, seagrass beds, marine lakes and mangrove forests.

Palau is internationally renowned for its' marine bio-diversity which includes over 1,300 species of fish, an abundance of large pelagic animals, and over 700 species of corals. Palau was chosen by National Geographic Society as the first Underwater Wonder of the World and was featured on Discovery

Channels “Living Eden’s” series as one of the world's last living “Eden’s”. Palau is home to one of the highest number of species not found anywhere else in the world and its marine habitats support a greater density of coral, fish, and other invertebrates than any other place on Earth. Seven of the nine species of giant “Tridacna” clams are found in Palau along with the world's most remote population of Dugongs.

### **Terrestrial Bio-Diversity**

While best known for amazing marine bio-diversity and a reputation as an underwater wonderland for scuba divers and snorkelers, Palau's terrestrial bio-diversity is equally diverse and stunning, making Palau an absolute treasure trove for avid birders and terrestrial naturalists of almost every interest.

Terrestrially, Palau is home to Micronesia's largest resident populations of bird, animal and plant species. The main island of Babeldaob is the second largest landmass in Micronesia (after Guam) and is recognized as one of the largest undisturbed tropical rainforests in Micronesia. Babeldaob is home to Ngardok Lake and Ngermeduu Bay, the largest natural lake and largest estuary in Micronesia, respectively. Palau has over 1,260 species of plants including over 800 that are native.

### **Climate & Weather**

Kids Sea Camp guest will be treated to a warm Thanksgiving this year! Palau is located approximately 7 degrees north of the equator and enjoys sunny tropical weather and pleasantly moderate temperatures year-round that average 82° F / 27° C.

As a tropical island Palau is subject to rainfall throughout the year though more frequently between July and October. It's not unusual to have brief but quite heavy daily showers early in the morning and late afternoon so all KSC guests should bring proper rain gear with them. It is recommended to bring your rain gear with you on all excursions just in case.

### **Water Temperature**

Water temperatures vary little throughout the year with the average temperatures being a pleasantly comfortable 82F / 27C year. For KSC guests a 3mm full or shorty wetsuit or dive-skin will work fine for most, while others may prefer the freedom of wearing swim suits / board shorts and a t-shirt or rash guard.

## **HELPFUL LOCAL INFORMATION**

### **Banking & Currency**

U.S. dollar is the official currency of Palau. Traveler’s checks and all major credit cards are accepted at most businesses, including Sam’s Tours. There are several banks (Bank of Hawaii, Bank of Guam, and Bank Pacific) and plenty of automated teller machines around town.

### **Health & Medical Services**

Palau National Hospital is a well-equipped and professionally staffed facility with an experienced Barotrauma Team. In addition there are excellent private clinics, out-patient surgeries and pharmacies on the island. Local supermarkets carry most common over-the-counter medications.

## **Dress Code**

The dress code in Palau makes it great for Kids...casual is in! Palau is a tropical island and a very casual place when it comes to attire. T-shirts, shorts and flip-flops (rubber slippers) are appropriate at all times with very few exceptions (thankfully, ties haven't become a hit here)! For those who want to dress up, a polo shirt, aloha shirt or blouse will usually suffice. Parents can leave the slacks and dresses at home if they want to! Short shorts and swimsuits are okay at the beach, pool and around the dive shop but not appropriate around town. Please keep in mind that many restaurants and the resort are heavily air-conditioned so if you get cold easy you might want to bring something to keep you warm!

## **What to Bring**

Pack lightly Kids Sea Camp! Palau is a warm tropical destination and casual attire (t-shirt, shorts and flip-flops) are perfect! Laundry service is very cheap and low cost T-shirts and shorts are available at almost every store.

## **Things KSC should not leave home without:**

Scuba Certification Card – (if diving) proof of certification is required from all divers.

DAN Membership and Insurance Card – always good to have this when traveling

Sunglasses & Hat – sunglasses, hats and T-shirts are also available at Sam's Tours if you forget.

Rain Jacket – Carry a waterproof rain jacket any time you're on the water. Heavy downpours can happen with little notice and can make for a chilly boat ride, especially after you've been diving.

Prescriptions Medications & Eye Glasses – bring any special medications you require.

Book(s) – If you like to read, bring a book as there are no book stores in Palau!

Sport Sandals (or Teva's) – for walking on the rock islands (**or** any shoes you don't mind getting wet). Dive booties work fine too! You can also rent hard-soled dive booties at Sam's Tours.

## **Electricity**

110 Volts 50/60Hz with U.S. type flat 2-pin plug or 3-pin (two flat pins and rounded ground pin). There is 220 VOLT service at the dive center for battery charging.

## **Language**

English is spoken by almost everyone on the island. Palauan is the local language. Japanese is also widely spoken. Languages spoken by our multi-lingual staff include Dutch, English, French, German, Japanese, Spanish, Swiss, and Taiwanese.

## **Medical Services**

Palau National Hospital is a well-equipped medical center with excellent professional medical staff. There are several private outpatient clinics and pharmacies in town. Should something arise, Sam's Tours staff will be able to help direct you in the right direction.

**Postal Service**

Palau is served by the U.S. Postal Service (USPS) so you will be able to send as many post cards back as you would like. It generally takes only 6-9 days to get mail back to the U.S. mainland via first class or priority mail.

**Telecommunications**

Kids Sea Camp guests will be able to call home whenever necessary. International direct dialing is readily available using Calling Cards from Palau National Communications Corporation (PNCC). Cards are available at Sam's Tours and many other business establishments.

Internet access is available at Sam's Tours and Palau Royal Resort.

Mobile phone service (GSM 900) is available on the island however international roaming is not available and phones will not operate without a SIM card purchased (or rented) locally.

**Time Zone**

Palau is Greenwich Mean Time (GMT) + 9 hours or the same as Japan. At present time we are 13 hours ahead of New York and 16 hours ahead of LA. An hour is added with day light savings time.

**Tipping**

Tipping is not required but is a common practice for all service personnel, dive guides and boat captains.

**Transportation**

There is no public transportation system in Palau. Sam's Tours will provide Kids Sea Camp guests with complimentary roundtrip hotel and downtown shuttle service for things outside KSC activities. Taxi service is also readily available up until 10:00pm and fares are very reasonable. Arrangements are easily made in advance for taxi service after 10:00pm.

For all Kids Sea Camp activities transportation is provided as needed.

**Quarantine Restrictions**

As Palau's unique island eco-system is very susceptible to invasive species there are tight restrictions on fresh fruits, vegetables, plants, meats and other possible sources of contamination. Do not bring these items to Palau as they are subject to immediate confiscation.

**Drugs**

Anti-drug laws are strictly enforced. Prescriptions should be carried for any special medicines or drugs in your possession.

**Departure Tax**

Palau has a departure tax of 20.00 for each departing visitor. Departure tax of \$20.00 has been included in all Kids Sea Camp package pricing and a representative from Sam's Tours will be on hand during departure to organize this.

### Boats

Sam's Tours has 9 custom built dive boats. Our custom built dive boats are safe, fast and comfortable and fully equipped for safety with twin engines, VHF Radio, Cell Phone, DAN Emergency Oxygen and full canopy for sun protection. Continuing our efforts to protect Palau's environment and improve the overall comfort of our guests, all boats have been outfitted with twin 4 stroke outboards (Yamaha).

These provide a much quieter ride and are much more fuel efficient

Our current fleet consists of four 30 foot vessels, four 33 foot vessels and one 40 foot vessel. All vessels contain dry storage, tank racks and rinse tanks. An assortment of juice, water and other beverages are available on all trips as well.

All of our vessels are operated by professionally licensed local captains who know Palau's waters and reefs better than anyone. They are a great source for knowledge of what Palau is all about

### Hyper Clean Air

We currently have two Bauer K-20 compressors that are equipped with an activated carbon Securus Filter System for hyper-clean compressed air. The system is U.S. laboratory tested every 90 days to ensure its constant purity and safety.

### Nitrox for Free

Nitrox is free for all qualified (nitrox certified) guest. Our state-of-the-art NRC Nitrox Membrane System safely and consistently produces precise Nitrox blends up to 36% at the push of a button. Our Nitrox tanks are available in US Yoke or DIN valves and clearly marked with yellow and green nitrox markings

### Scuba Tanks

All of our scuba tanks are U.S. manufactured aluminum cylinders, D.O.T. certified and maintained in accordance with U.S. standards for visual inspections and hydrostatic testing. For personal diving comfort guests are offered a selection of scuba tank sizes to choose from and a choice of valve types from U.S. standard yoke valves to higher pressure DIN valves. Our assortment of tanks include 53, 67, 80 and 100 cubic feet (smaller tanks will be provided for Kids Sea Camp)

## **Electrical Power**

110 and 220 Volt power sources are provided at our Digital Photo Center for camera, strobe and other battery charging needs.

## **Digital Photo Center**

Kids Sea Camp guests will have use of Sam's Tours Digital Photography Center. The center is fully equipped to cater to digital photographers of all interest levels from those with handy "point-and-shoot" cameras to the most demanding digital photographers shooting in RAW format. Our six top of the line Apple iMac workstations are loaded with terabytes and terabytes of storage, archiving and secure data back up systems, lots of RAM, and completely optimized for digital imaging with Apple Aperture image management software, Adobe Photoshop Elements, Bridge, Toast, and topped off with DSL Wi-Fi internet access.

Don't feel like bringing your camera with you...Kids Sea Camp guests can also rent camera equipment at the photo center. Our rental equipment includes the latest Canon Powershot SD850 digital cameras and Canon ZR830 mini digital video cameras complete with underwater housings, large storage media, plenty of additional batteries, and full service support from our professionally trained Photo Center staff.

Other Photo Center amenities include a padded and dry camera prep table, battery charging stations, 110V and 220V electrical supply, separate camera rinse tanks, camera drying station equipped with towels and compressed air, and secure storage for your housings, equipment cases and other accessories.

## **Guest Locker**

Sam's Tours has a large secure "wet storage" guest locker for KSC. The locker is equipped with shelves and hanging racks, good ventilation and floor drainage for safe storage of our customer's personal equipment including large suitcases and other bags that are not required on the dive boat. It is locked and secure when not in use.

### **Equipment Rinse Tanks**

the dive center is equipped with separate rinse tanks for camera equipment, dive gear and wetsuits. 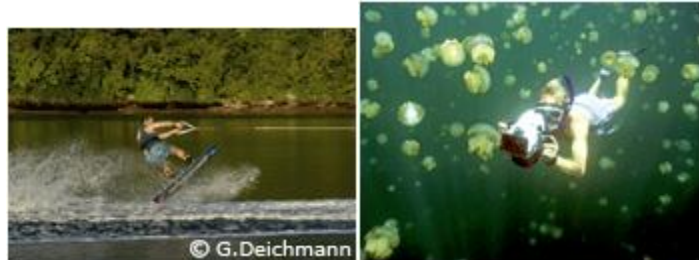

### **Rock Island Tour/Jellyfish Lake - Everyone will go on this tour!**

After a long flight this is the perfect way to kick off Kids Sea Camp Palau!

KSC guests will enjoy a guided rock island tour offering an exciting full day of sightseeing, snorkeling and exploring throughout Palau's enchanting islands and a bounty of beautiful sights & scenes.

Snorkel vibrant coral reefs teeming with colorful marine life. Swim with the prehistoric inhabitants of mysterious Jellyfish Lake. Relax on white sandy beaches. Cruise through the fascinating geological formations of the Rock Islands. Lunch will be served on one of Palau's amazing beaches. If this doesn't wet your appetite for the week ahead...nothing will!

### **Full Day Guided Kayak Tour (Non-Diver Package)**

Sam's Tours Planet Blue offers six amazing kayak & snorkeling day tours that deliver a diversity of paddling trips combined with Palau's most spectacular inner lagoon snorkel sites.

Led by world class local naturalists, all tours include a gentle mix of paddling, snorkeling, birding, exploring, and beach time, featuring pristine coral gardens, reef fish nurseries, hidden lagoons, marine caves, limestone tunnels, forgotten WWII sites, ancient Palauan villages, and breathtaking tropical beaches. With speed boat shuttles to and from the Rock Islands, every tour is guaranteed to be a relaxing experience.

### **Babeldaob Island Tour (Non Diver Package)**

This tour offers great views, a visit to a traditional Palauan village and Bai, the famous Stone monoliths and an insight into traditional Palauan culture.

Melekeok is a Palauan village on the eastern coast of Babeldaob, one of the most beautiful and pristine coastlines in Palau. The views on the way to the Bai are spectacular.

The tour includes a visit to the Melekeok Bai, a traditional Palauan meeting house, with surrounding stone paths, stone faces, and a lush jungle forest.

Malahi, our seasoned Palauan guide, will share her vast knowledge of Palauan culture and history. She is familiar with the details of the Palauan histories and traditional Palauan stories, including those depicted on the Melekeok Bai.

You will also visit the Stone monoliths and taking in the amazing scenery of Babeldaob's north shore and the surrounding islands. It is recommended that the guests wear an old pair of tennis shoes or sport-style sandals for foot protection during the hike and bring along some swimwear and sun protection.

### **Ngardmau Waterfall Hike (Non Diver Package)**

This is a half day excursion that you don't want to miss. Ngardmau Waterfall is simply amazing! A 40 minute hike through the jungle will get you to the Ngardmau waterfall - a dramatic fall, considered to be Palau's premier waterfall. The hike is suited for beginners with breathtaking views and the sounds of birds filling the air. Be sure to pack your camera for the many photo ops along the way!

It is recommend that the guests wear an old pair of tennis shoes or sport-style sandals for foot protection during the hike and bring along some swimwear and sun protection.

### **City Tour and Palau International Coral Reef Center (non divers full tour) (seal and sasy aquarium only)**

This tour centers on the city center of Koror. We are lucky here in Palau to have several museums and an aquarium. KSC guests will visit the Palau National Museum, The Etpison Museum, The Mariculture Center, Crocodile Farm and The International Coral Reef Center. Guests will learn about the history and culture that makes Palau such a special place. The International Coral Reef Center will give non divers an opportunity to see what the divers in their families are looking at. This is a day full of learning about this magical place!
