- Assist the team to standardize, automate and document setup of development and production environments.
- Help define best practices for source control, continuous integration automated testing and release management.
- Collaborate with peers on work estimation/planning and implementation of new versions/features of tools.
- Build tools for internal use to support software engineering best practices.
- Bring new automation technologies to improve speed and quality of releasing products.
- Help implement new and improve existing monitoring and trending solutions to assist in the team's ability to identify and respond to issues.
- The position will require being available to perform maintenance during non-business hours and over the weekends.

- Experience with multiple cloud computing and storage platforms (AWS, Azure)
- Strong background and experience with Windows and Linux configurations.
- Experience with monitoring tools (Datadog, New Relic)

- Understanding core business processes (Financial and Distribution) is a plus
