

# PADI course credits for Nationally Recognised Training and Certificates of Education in Australia

## Nationally Recognised Training (NRT) – Nationwide

PADI Asia Pacific Pty Ltd is a Registered Training Organisation (RTO) [#6729](#). PADI RTO is registered with the Australian Skills Quality Authority (ASQA), Australia's national regulator for Vocational Education and Training (VET) and complies with the *Standards for Registered Training Organisations (RTOs) 2015*. This allows PADI RTO to issue Nationally Recognised Training (NRT) certificates, called Statements of Attainment, to students who complete their Nationally Recognised Training with an authorised, PADI RTO Trainer. These certificates may credit towards higher level certificates or diplomas within the Australian Qualifications Framework (AQF)

The courses available include various diving courses (mainly from the Sport, Fitness and Recreation Training Package) and non-diving courses (mainly from the Health Training Package).
